The Institute for Human Services and Civility at Edinboro University will be a 25,600 sq. ft. facility designed to meet LEED® Silver Certification. It will utilize numerous Green Building features, not the least of which is a Geothermal System for year-round heating and cooling.

The new facility will have Wireless Networking throughout to serve the classrooms, seminar rooms and tiered lecture hall. The University's Department of Speech and Hearing Diagnostic & Education will also be housed in the complex.

The Institute will draw resources from the University and the community to build human civility and social justice. It will provide regional support through collaborative service, teaching, and research initiatives.
